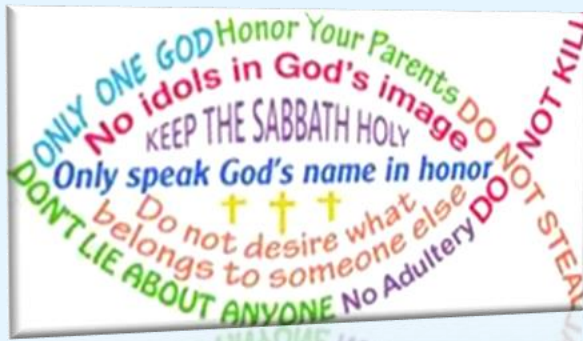


From the foreword by Cardinal Angelo Comastri:
